
Worship in January & Beyond

As you might recall, in order to make room for the people who are already here and to plan for future growth, we are making plans to have two Sunday morning worship services. Slightly over 50 percent of those responding to our survey said they are best able to



connect with God through traditional worship. The rest of those surveyed find contemporary or blended worship (a combination of contemporary songs and hymns) helps them best connect with God.

As a result of all this, The Leadership Council and Pastor Robert decided to move to the following worship schedule with the aim of starting in the month of January:



- 10 to 10:45 am Social Gathering in Fellowship Hall
- 10:45-11:45 am Blended Worship

However, in January we will continue with our one 10 am Traditional service until a Blended Service Worship leader is hired. If you or if you know someone who is interested in this ministry position resumes may be sent to plattecityumc@gmail.com. You can see the ad that has been used posted below.

Once a Blended Worship leader is hired, we will begin to move toward our new schedule. At that time will continue to offer Children's Sunday School lessons during the 9 am Traditional Service identical to how it is now.

Unfortunately, at this time, we only have enough children's ministry volunteers for the 9 am Traditional Service. For the 10:45 Blended Service, we would like to offer a time for children to worship together through music and activities that build on that week's lesson. This would not be a repeat of the Sunday School lesson offered at the 9:00am Traditional Service but a continuation of the lesson. In order for us to offer this during the 10:45 Blended Service, we will need some more volunteers. We are encouraging the families who utilize this service to be Safe Gathering Certified and rotate facilitating Children's Worship at the 10:45 service. 


